Situated in the Top West Islands of the Torres Strait, Malu Kiwai Campus provides education to approximately 90 boys and girls from Pre-prep to Year 7. Our school services the community of Boigu Island (which is located approximately 4.5kms from the Papua New Guinea coastline.
